## State Show Activities

State Show 2007 is now history in the books, but the memories will be with us forever. For those CGA members and their families that couldn't make it this year, this article could better be titled, "What Did I Miss?" For those of you at State Show participating in the non-horse activities each day, there were many new and fun memories made, along with a lot of laughs and teamwork. Most activities were run shortly after the day's horse show was over, while some of the lengthier activities were on-going throughout the day.

This State Show introduced Bolados for the first time. Bolados are a form of paper money used to buy all sorts of merchandise from the Teen Store. Bolados were earned by all participants in the State Show Activities, with extra Bolados going to the winners and placers in each activity. It would be an understatement to say that Bolados were popular, when in fact, Oh My Gosh, they were Extremely Popular! I'm not a betting type, but I'd bet you five Bolados that everyone at State Show had heard of them by the end of the show week.

The Activities Team (Wendy Hagerman, Pat Palmer, Stacy Rivera and Sally Rivera Lingafeldt) soon realized that kids would do pretty much anything to get more Bolados. Especially after the Teen Store opened up on Tuesday and began trading merchandise for Bolados. The catch: Although anyone was welcome to play in the Activities and earn Bolados, only those under 21 years of age could cash in Bolados for merchandise from the Teen Store. And believe me, there was plenty of merchandise to be bought! The Draw A Master Judge contest began on Saturday, set-ups day, the day before the 'real' show started. Would be artists and non-artists picked up their drawing materials and a list of CGA's master judges. On Tuesday night, all artwork was due back to the Show Activities office for judging. Due back, that is, to the Wendy Hagerman & Pat Palmer camp, headquarters for all State Show Activities for the week.

Our artwork judge and an actual artist was Pat Palmer.

Extra Bolados were awarded to drawings in the following categories: Best Effort, Most Entertaining Effort, and Most Excruciating Effort. All drawings were on display for the week for all to see.

Saturday's show was immediately followed by meetings and more meetings. The Water Balloon Target Practice with our new CGA President Skip Hofman as the target had to be delayed. On Sunday, after the first day of CGA events completed, a no-top golf cart was borrowed for the Skip Hofman Water Balloon Target Practice. Skip courageously drove the golf cart back and forth through Arena 2, while hordes of laughing youngsters took their best shots from the edge of the grandstands with what seemed like a never ending supply of water balloons. Someone threw Skip a huge supersoaker squirt gun, and Skip began spraying the stands. Lots of laughter, shrieks and more laughter followed. After the fun seemed to be over, Skip drove off through the arena only to find an errant water truck laying in wait by the gate. Yep, you guessed it! Skip was soaked! Thank you, Skip, for being such a great sport!

Sunday also brought the Tarp Rescue Race. This was a team event where, at the buzzer, the handsome prince sprints to the princess laying on a tarp waiting to be

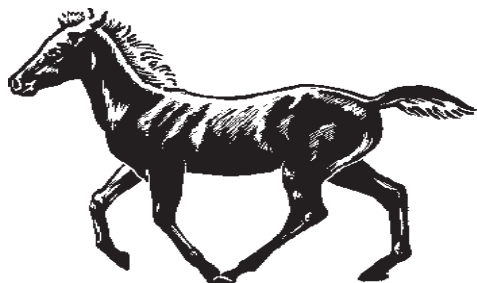

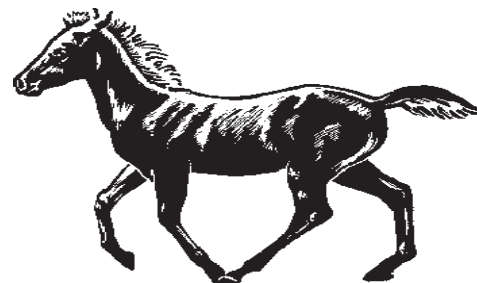

## Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

### For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

**Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots**

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
